

## Listening Skills — Major & Minor Tonality

## Activity — Part 1

- Write a four bar loop
- Use all major chords (for example |E / / |A / / |D / / |G / / |)
- Play it and listen to the interactions between the chords

## Activity — Part 2

- Alter all the chords so they are minor (for example |Em / / |Am / / |Dm / / |Gm / / |)
- Play it again and listen to how it has changed

## Activity — Part 3

- Now choose a mixture of major and minor chords
- Keep swapping them around until you've found a combination you like (for example - |Em / / |Am / / |D / / |G / / |)
- Listen to how altering just one of the chords completely changes the sound
