BA Musical Theatre Studies

The application process for this programme is simple and begins with your UCAS application.

When you have made your UCAS application, assuming you have or are likely to achieve the entry requirements, we will share a link to upload your personal statement and arrange an online interview.

At Leeds Conservatoire we do not charge application or audition fees for our programmes. If you have an interest in applying for our programmes, we don't want finances to be a barrier to you gaining access to our application processes.

Personal Statement

As part of your application we will ask you to submit a written statement (maximum 500 words) or introductory video (2-3 Minutes) that tells us in brief:

- Who you are
- Where you are on your learning journey
- What you hope to gain from the learning on the programme
- What you are hoping to do when you have completed your undergraduate degree

We use an online system called Acceptd, which you will need to use to upload your personal statement. Full details on how to access Acceptd will be sent to you following your application.

Interview

On receipt of your application we will be in touch to arrange an informal chat online with one of the Senior School of Drama staff team who will ask a series of short questions about your interest, experience and knowledge of musical theatre to date.

This is also your opportunity to ask any questions you have about Leeds Conservatoire and the Musical Theatre Studies programme.
